The Berkshire Edge welcomes letters to the editor. Publication is at the sole discretion of the editor.

In order to maintain civil discourse, we have established guidelines: All letters to the editor should advance the conversation; no nastiness, misinformation, or personal attacks are allowed.

To ensure space for a wide range of viewpoints, The Edge will publish no more than one letter per writer each week. That said, we welcome ongoing dialogue between readers, and we encourage those who wish to engage more actively to use the comment section at the bottom of each article. You can do this by creating a free account with Disqus.com or logging in with your email. All comments are publicly visible.

All letters to the editor should include the author's name, street address, email address and phone number. Only the author's name and town will be included in the final publication. The other information allows The Edge to verify the source.
